2. Countertop Shields and Screens

The Guardian™ Shield is a plexiglass sneeze guard ideal for most retail settings, including DIY stores and garden centres. The shields are built to help in reducing the spread of contagious, airborne germs

The Guardian™ creates a protective shield in any place of commerce that requires direct interaction between employees and customers in close proximity such as PoS checkouts.

As well as providing a protective barrier at the point of sale, the Guardian™ also creates peace of mind for employees and customers during face-to-face interactions


The acrylic counter top screen comes with options for the size and shape to suit most retail environments.

The retail Guardian™ reduces the risk of virus spread whilst allowing items to be exchanged at the checkout through a protective barrier.




3. Countertop Shields and Screen Types

There are three types of Guardiانت™ Shields, as shown below.




Angled sides

4. Face Shields

This basic Face Shield is useful for staff who are moving about stores and garden centre, and who may need to interact with customers, delivery drivers, etc.

The transparent part of the shield is manufactured from Polyethylene Terephthalate Glycol (PETG) and is connected to a foam headband. It is possible to wear glasses at the same time as wearing the shield.

It is a low cost product that is available in single units or in packs of 100.



5. Face Masks (Bio)

These TheraMasks - Performance Copper Masks - are a high quality alternative to face shields, and can be used by staff who move about the store/garden centres serving customers as well as those that are stationed at tills.

Although they do not give the same level of protection as face shields they are more comfortable and convenient to use.

They have the following features:

- Reusable
- Machine washable up to 30 times
- Reduces facial contamination
- One size fits most



6. Face Masks (OEKO-TEX® Standard 100 Certified)

An alternative Thermamask these OEKO-TEX® Standard 100 certified fabric masks are made from 100% polyester and OEKO-TEX® Standard 100 Class I certified.

They are suitable for prolonged contact with the skin and are sterilised with an ozone treatment before being packed . They are machine washable at up to 40°C.

These facemasks are intended for personal use in non-medical settings in the hope of helping to contain the spread of the virus. These are not medical devices and no claim is (or can be) made that the mask is a defence against contracting a virus.



7. Pricing Information (continued)

Face Masks

There are now two types of masks, both of which are washable:

TheraMasks Face Masks, which are sourced from the USA, have an 8 day lead time.

25+ masks : £33.60 per mask

350+ masks: £22.20 per mask

OEKO-TEX® Standard 100 certified fabric masks are manufactured in the UK and have a lead time of eight days. However, if a 15% premium is paid the lead time can be reduced to two days.
